

HOW DOES "LIVING YOUR MISSION" CHANGE A SCHOOL? When ENKA decided to act upon its stated value of Equality-- that neither religion,

ethnicity, geographical origin, nor financial standing shall preclude a student from enrolling-- something radical happened. While the school has had a longstanding enrolling-- something radical happened. While the school has had a longstanding committement to provide **financial aid to every enrolled student whose family demonstrates need**, six years ago the school decided to add academic scholarships to its bursary offerings. Since doing so, **the school's supporting foundation has granted 148 full academic scholarships to** transfer students, who typically rank scholastically in the top 1% of the nation. In combination with the other bursary options, this means that **currently 41% of ENKA's high school is on full scholarship.** To make opportunity more accessible to more students, three years ago (despite the pandemic), ENKA opened its residential boarding facilities, which now houses **62 academic scholarship students from 14 different provinces**, which is 15% of the high school student body. The rigor of our academics, the organic challenge spurred by a growing number of academic scholarship students, and the diversity engendered by students from different regions has allowed the school to truly live its mission and witness the edifying results.

THE SCHOOL

ENKA is a private, non-profit Pre-K-12 co-educational school in Istanbul, Turkey. Founded in 1996 as a center of educational excellence, ENKA aims to provide an inspirational model for schools within Turkey and internationally.

Our academic programs foster global awareness and incorporate academic excellence. ENKA offers multiple rigorous curricula which promote a globally-minded student population who leárn leadership and responsibility.

ENKA is fully authorized K-12 to offer all three IB programs: PYP, MYP, and DP. ENKA is the first Turkish school in the country authorized for IBPYP. Additionally, ENKA offers a range of AP courses as well as university preparation courses.

THE CAMPUS

The campus, which now includes an expanding residential program, is situated on the European side of Istanbul in the heart of the business center, nestled in 16 wooded acres within the ENKA Sports complex.

The range of facilities demonstrates the importance ENKA places on contemporary education, sports, and the arts. Facilities include three full science labs, a design tech lab, a robotics lab, three libraries totaling 40,000 volumes, computer labs, a multimedia room, a student kitchen, and contemporary, purpose-built classrooms. In addition, the school has an amphitheater, a music hall, an art gallery, two indoor pools, an outdoor olympic-sized pool, twelve tennis courts, a full gymnasium, fitness center, and a tartan track and field.

The residential facilities currently house 15% of the high school students-- those who have transferred in from other cities around Turkey. This number will continue to grow.





Assessment & Grading

All grades in Turkish High Schools are recorded on the Turkish Ministry of Education's 100 point scale. ENKA uses this scale. However, it should be noted that grading is very competitive. Thus, we encourage you to refer to our adjacent chart showing the individual school distribution of grades at ENKA.

ENKA does not rank students. Students are given grades each semester and the final course grade is an average of the two semesters.

IBDP and AP class grades are unweighted and are reported on the same 100% Turkish scale. An average of 85% is required to earn high honors. An average of 70% is required to earn academic honors. A passing grade is 50% in grade 12.

Community Service is highly emphasized at the core of ENKA School's mission and this is reflected throughout K-12 as an embedded part of the curriculum.

Students volunteer regularly throughout Istanbul as well as in community service projects throughout Turkey and internationally. Groups of students and teachers have engaged in outreach in underdeveloped areas in Turkey and abroad to help disadvantaged children in Baksi, Finike, Gaziantep, Urfa, Nepal, and other locations.


